Nominated students must:

- Be a Hamilton County resident
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Demonstrate financial need
- Graduate by the end of June 2016 with a diploma from an accredited Indiana high school, but not have graduated before the start of the 2015-2016 school year (students graduating mid-year are eligible)
- Plan to pursue a full-time baccalaureate course of study beginning in the fall of 2016 at a public or private college or university in Indiana
- Demonstrate a commitment to community volunteerism
- Demonstrate leadership and/or initiative in their school, community, and/or extracurricular activities

Nominated students must:

- Be a Marion County resident
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Demonstrate financial need
- Graduate by the end of June 2016 with a diploma from an accredited Indiana high school, but not have graduated before the start of the 2015 -2016 school year (students graduating mid-year are eligible)
- Plan to pursue a full-time baccalaureate course of study beginning in the fall of 2016 at a public or private college or university in Indiana
- Demonstrate motivation and/or a high level of responsibility through school, community, family, and/or extracurricular activities

Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship Program Student Nomination Procedures Hamilton County

A committee at each school will make the student nominations to the Foundation **via the specified email form** by Wednesday, November 11, 2015. Typically, the committees include several teachers and guidance staff (no committee members can be related to any applicants). Guidance counselors often serve as contacts and make nominations, but the principal is ultimately responsible for verifying the nominees. Legacy Fund will allow two Hamilton County nominees per accredited high school.

CICF must receive one email nomination form per nominated student. A copy of the form is included in this packet and further instructions will be sent with the form in late September.

- **December 14, 2015:** Student applications for the Lilly Scholarship are due to CICF. No exceptions.
- **February 5, 2016:** Hamilton County Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship interviews. Students and guidance counselors will receive an email with the student's interview time.
- **February 18, 2016:** Marion County Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship interviews. Students and guidance counselors will receive an email with the student's interview time.
- **April 2016:** All students are notified of selection status/committee's decisions.
