Students applying to Groups need to submit the following by **NOVEMBER 1!**

- IU Groups Application: <http://go.iu.edu/27Ri>
- IU Groups Recommendation letter (from a Groups recommender) only if student's GPA is below 2.8.
 - I am a Groups recommender if your school does not have one
- Copy of Student birth certificate or Green Card to submit by email (groups@indiana.edu) or fax 812-856-5835
- Students ALSO need to complete the following for IU Admissions:
 - IU Admission Application (May choose ANY 3 applications) (www.admissions.indiana.edu)
 - Groups Fee Waiver (email me if needed)
 - Official transcripts (mail or parchment only)
 - Application Essay: Please have students indicate Groups interest in their essay!
 - Official test scores (sent from testing agency)
- FAFSA: Groups is recommending that students complete their FAFSA by November 1st.

**Students need to take an ACT or SAT and receive scores prior to November 1 to be eligible
