Blumberg Scholarship

One \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to an incoming freshman, majoring in Special Education or Communication Disorders. The scholarship is renewable for up to four years (maximum award of \$6,000) and can be combined with other Indiana State University scholarships.

Blumberg Scholars

Blumberg Scholars will gain valuable experience by participating in Blumberg Center activities (50 contact hours per semester) during their time at Indiana State University. Such activities may include assisting with professional development programs for Indiana educators, participating in learning experiences with educators and families, and facilitating disability awareness activities on campus.



Scholarship Eligibility

Scholarship selection is based on:

- previous work/volunteer experiences
- recommendations
- current high school transcript
- class rank
- GPA
- SAT/ACT scores

Application and supporting documentation is due by March 1, 2018
